# Diagnostic scoring

Alvarado Score (AS)		Pediatric Appendicitis Score (PAS)	
Diagnostic criteria	Value	Diagnostic criteria	Value
Migration of pain	1	Migration of pain	1
Anorexia / ketones in urine	1	Anorexia	1
Nausea / vomiting	1	Nausea / emesis	1
Tenderness in right lower quadrant	2	Tenderness in right lower quadrant	2
Rebound pain	1	Cough / percussion / hopping tenderness	2
Elevation of temperature (≥ 37.3 °C)	1	Fever (≥ 38 °C)	1
Leukocytosis (> 10,000/µl)	2	Leukocytosis (> 10,000/µl)	1
Neutrophilia (> 75%)	1	Neutrophilia (> 75%)	1
Total	10	Total	10

Recommendations: <4 = Look for an alternate diagnosis >4 pts= Work up



### **POCUS for appendicits** Probe & Anatomy



Scan point of maximal tenderness

#### OR

- Landmark Technique
  - Anterior to the iliac vessels
  - Medial to psoas muscle

#### Subcutaneous fat

#### Internal oblique and transversus abdominis muscles

External iliac artery

Iliopsoas muscle

External iliac vein

# Normal vs. Appendicitis

### NORMAL

- Less than 6mm
- Compressible
- Lack of peristalsis



### APPENDICITIS

- Greater than 6mm
- NON compressible
- Lack of peristalsis
- Possible appendicolith
- Hyperechoic surrounding fat and inflammation
- Hyperemia "ring of fire"
- Surrounding free fluid



## Ultrasound findings of acute appendicitis Primary findings

Greater than 6mm from outer wall to outer wall



Presence of an appendicolith


